Dear friends in Christ:

On Friday, we celebrated the Feast of the Sacred Heart, another wonderful feast day in the life of the Church. The First Friday of every month is especially dedicated to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Here at SJV, we pray the novena and Litany of the Sacred Heart on First Fridays. Throughout the history of the Church, devotion to Jesus and his Sacred Heart has been a source of spiritual grace and blessing. The heart of Jesus represents his great and infinite love for us.

From the earliest days of the Church, the Heart of Jesus has received special devotion from the followers of Christ. Devotion to the Sacred Heart is an expression of our faith in Jesus as true God and true man. Even more so, it is a belief in his divine love and passionate care for us in our needs and struggles. As Blessed John Henry Newman said, it is "cor ad cor loquitur" (Heart Speaking to Heart!) The love of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit for one another now includes us! God speaks to our hearts in love and we are able to feel, know and experience his love. Moreover, because of God's transforming love for us in Jesus, we are able love him in return with all the love and passion of our hearts. Chief among the devotions to the Sacred Heart are the promises that Jesus revealed to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in 1670. These promises express Jesus' mercy for us and His desire that we may stay close to him. Of the promises, I find consolation in the fact that Jesus doesn't want us just merely to be passive recipients of his goodness, but rather he desires for us to be his active co-workers.

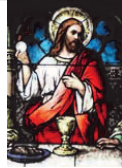
Promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus

1. *I will give them all the graces necessary for their state of life.*
2. *I will give peace in their families.*
3. *I will console them in all their troubles.*
4. *I will be their refuge in life and especially in death.*
5. *I will abundantly bless all their undertakings.*
6. *Sinners shall find in my Heart the source and Infinite Ocean of mercy.*
7. *Tepid souls shall become fervent.*
8. *Fervent souls shall rise speedily to great perfection.*
9. *I will bless those places wherein the image of My Sacred Heart shall be exposed and venerated.*
10. *I will give to priests the power to touch the most hardened hearts.*
11. *Persons who propagate this devotion shall have their names eternally written in my Heart.*
12. *In the excess of the mercy of my Heart, I promise you that my all powerful love will grant to all those who will receive Communion on the First Fridays, for nine consecutive months, the grace of final repentance: they will not die in my displeasure, nor without receiving the sacraments; and my Heart will be their secure refuge in that last hour.*

These promises encourage us to grow in our faith and love of Jesus. They hearten us in the confidence that Jesus is with us and loves us especially when we find ourselves in need. They also challenge us to grow in the work of evangelization by making Christ and his love known to others by outwardly proclaiming and living our friendship and love of the Lord. If you do not have an image of the Sacred Heart in your home, I encourage you to obtain one and display it with faith and devotion. I encourage you to express your love for Christ by coming to First Friday Mass or making regular visits to the adoration chapel or perhaps praying the Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Whether or not a couple attends the ceremony, they are eligible to receive a special recognition.

Couples wishing to participate are asked to register on line by visiting www.archgh.org/25thWedding. Please fill out all the information requested and make sure that the name of each couple is **typed exactly** as they wish them to appear on their recognition. Deadline for registration is **July 8th, 2013 at noon NO EXEPTIONS**; soon after, the archdiocesan Office of Family Life Ministry will send registered couples an electronic message with detailed information about their participation in the Jubilee Mass. Registration will not be processed if the information about the Catholic Wedding cannot be verified and/or if the fee of \$25 dollars per couple is not received before July 10th. Each couple will be able to bring a maximum of 6 family members or friends to the Mass.

Later, at the end of July we will be opening registrations for the 50th anniversary couples.

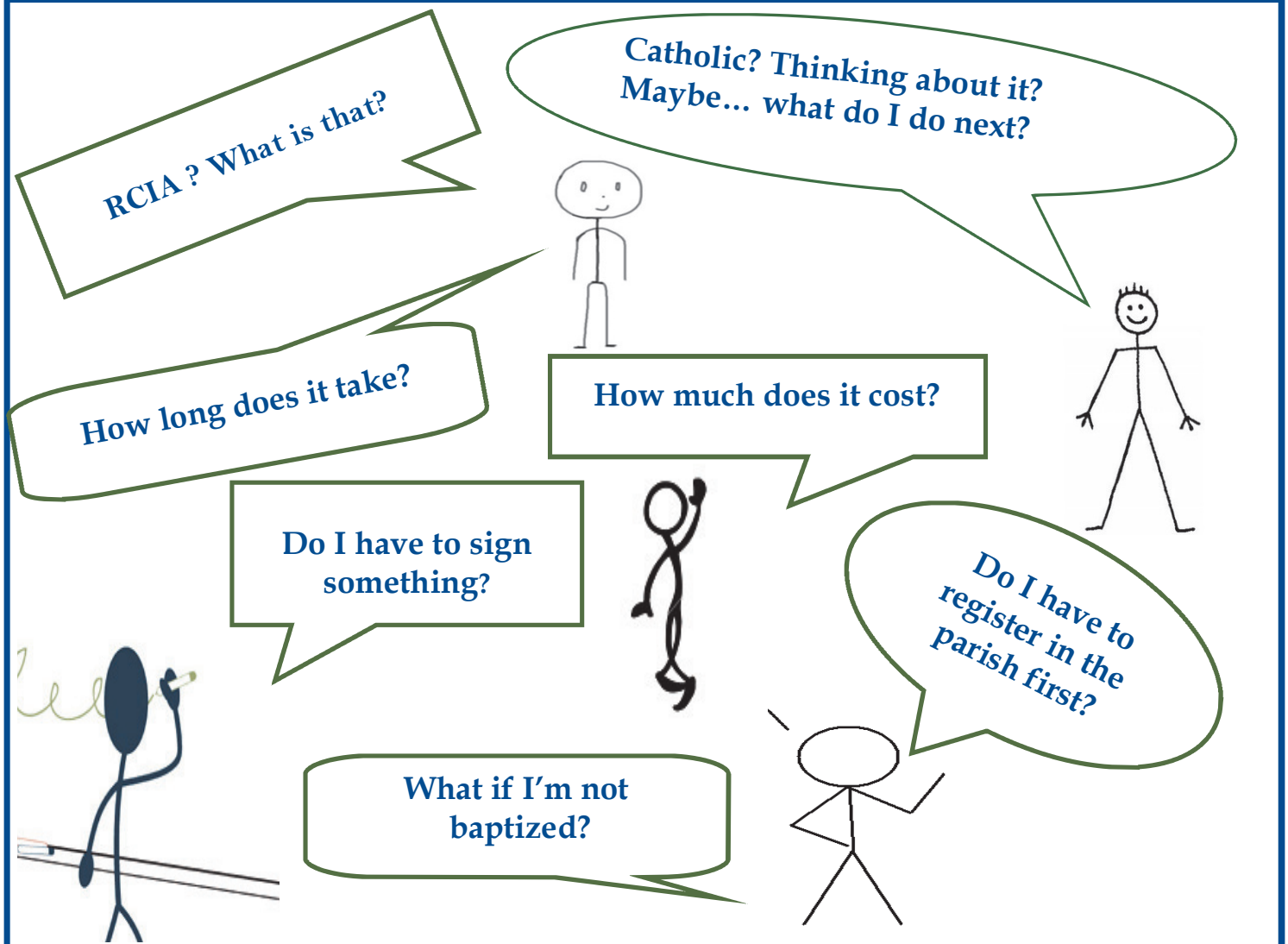

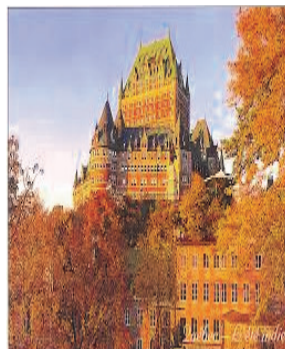
